



Maintenance guidelines

Welcome!

Congratulations on your investment in K9Grass[®] by ForeverLawn[®]. K9Grass is the synthetic grass designed specifically for dogs and is the premier surfacing product for pets everywhere.

We want to make sure that your experience with K9Grass is as enjoyable and successful as possible. This document provides general maintenance guidelines with common thresholds. We recommend contacting your local ForeverLawn dealer for how to best tailor these solutions for your specific application.

Proper K9Grass Maintenance

General Guidelines

Debris such as leaves and sticks should be removed regularly. Leaf rakes and blowers are great tools to accomplish this.

Remove solid pet waste frequently. If the solid waste is messy, pick up all you can, rinse with a hose, and treat with a bacterial enzyme. **Do not rinse solid waste into the grass.**

It is advisable to have a spray bottle filled with premixed bacterial enzyme to treat spots where waste is removed. We recommend Got Pee Odor Eliminator, which can be purchased through your ForeverLawn dealer. The product is a concentrate so it can be easily diluted for use in hand-held spray bottles. This product activates and continues to work as long as there is moisture and pet waste present. In lieu of a hose applicator, rinse K9Grass well with a hose and mist grass with a premixed spray (6 - 8 ounces per gallon), applied with a pump sprayer.

If another brand is used, we recommend that you consult with the manufacturer to confirm that it is safe to use with dogs.

Bacterial Enzyme Treatment

Comprehensive treatment of your K9Grass with a bacterial enzyme should be done regularly. The purpose of these treatments is to break down residual pet waste which, if not addressed, can be the source of odor or unsanitary conditions. The recommended hose attachment is available for purchase from your ForeverLawn dealer.

This bacterial enzyme treatment should be applied on a regular interval to prevent odors. For best results, leave the bacterial enzyme on the grass a longer period of time.

For indoor applications, this treatment should be done once per day at minimum. For outdoor use, we recommend starting at a weekly interval and increasing or decreasing frequency based on results. This treatment can also be applied reactively any time there is an odor.

Frequency of treatment will be dependent on the size of the area, number of dogs, climate, use, and design of installation. Consult your local ForeverLawn dealer for specific guidelines.

Removing Debris

It is important to remove hair and smaller debris to keep K9Grass visually appealing and performing its best. This will also prevent restricted drainage and unwanted waste harbored in the grass.

To remove debris, run a vacuum with a rotating brush and strong suction on the dry turf to groom, agitate, and clean the surface.

For installations under 1,500 square feet, a household vacuum can be used. Larger areas may require a commercial vacuum or a power broom. Frequency is dependent on size, traffic, and area use. Contact your local dealer for specific recommendations for your unique application.

Outdoor area: Vacuum hair and small debris at an initial frequency of once per month. Remember, this is a starting point and will likely need to be adjusted by monitoring the amount of debris and hair collected. High-use outdoor areas may require weekly vacuuming. A shop vac can be used around the perimeter, such as near a fence and/or wall.

Indoor area: Vacuum hair and small debris at an initial frequency of once every other day. A commercial-grade carpet extractor is preferred for indoor use as it can be run when the grass is wet, pulling out hair and debris while also removing residual water. This frequency will likely need adjusted by monitoring the amount of debris and hair removed. It is very common for daily vacuuming and extraction to be required for indoor areas. A shop vac can be used around the perimeter, such as near a fence and/or wall.

Additional Notes

- Rinsing outdoor areas between cleanings is advised if you do not experience regular rainfall.
- If you have a sick dog, clean and sanitize the area by removing the bulk matter and applying Got Pee Odor Eliminator to the affected area. Allow the bacterial action to consume and liquefy blood, urine, feces, and vomit. Rinse the area with water to flush away contaminants.
- If you have a flushing system installed, dilute urine and move it to the drain. Consult your ForeverLawn dealer regarding frequency and duration.
- **Do not** use power lawn care equipment on the turf. ForeverLawn is not responsible for damage caused by equipment such as mowers, weeders, heaters, or power washers.
